Dr Koichi Iwatsuki, a neurosurgeon who has successfully transplanted neural stem cells in spinal cord injury patients will talk on his successful outcome.

As a part of the NCRM NICHE, the Fujio Cup Quiz on Stem Cells & Regenerative Medicine is held for the Sixth time this year which will take place in the afternoon in which Medical & Biotech students from all over the country are participating and the valedictory session will be graced by the **Consul General of Japan at Chennai, Mr. Masanori Nakano**.
